INWPR adopts pugs only to homes willing to make a lifetime commitment to their Pugs. Pugs are to be treated as family members. They require a quality diet, to be given regular medical care and vaccinations. INWPR has the right to reclaim any Pug if the circumstances warrant such action. Should an adopter ever have to give up the Pug, it will be returned back to Inland Northwest Pug Rescue at no charge to INWPR.
